ORDER No. 270 of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 18 December 2020

on the suspension of practical classes delivered at the University

Pursuant to art. 52.3 of resolution No. 37 of the Senate of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of 16 April 2019 the Statutes of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (Biuletyn Prawny UMK of 2019, item 120 as amended) in connection with the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of 9 October 2020 on the establishment of specific restrictions, orders and prohibitions in connection with the state of epidemic (Dz.U. of 2020, item 1758 as amended)

it is ordered as follows:

Article 1

- 1. Subject to art. 1.2, teaching classes of a practical nature, which under Order No. 228 of the NCU Rector of 19 October 2020 on preventing the spread of SARS -CoV-2 among community members of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń in the red zone (Biuletyn Prawny UMK of 2020, item 367 as amended) were delivered on the University premises (on-site or in a hybrid mode) shall be delivered in the remote mode in the period from 4 January 2020 to 31 January 2021.
- 2. In particularly justified cases, the competent deans may decide to continue delivering practical classes on-site or in a hybrid mode in regulated medical fields of study at Collegium Medicum, in the veterinary field and in the last semester of engineering studies.
- 3. During the period referred to art. 1.1, all final credit assessments and examinations shall be conducted in the remote mode.
- 4. In the period referred to in art. 1.1, office hours and consultations of the staff members shall take place in remote mode.

Article 2

The order becomes effective as of 18 December 2020.
