ORDER No. 160

of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 30 June, 2021

amending the order on the organization of education at the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń in the summer semester of the 2020/2021 academic year

Based on Article 67 sec. 4 of the Act of July 20, 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) and § 52 item 3 of resolutions No. 37 of the NCU Senate of April 16, 2019 of the Statute of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (NCU Legal Bulletin of 2019, item 120, as amended) in connection with § 12 of the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of September 27, 2018 on studies (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1861, as amended)

it is ordered as follows:

§ 1

In Order No. 3 of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University of January 19, 2021 on the organization of education at the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń in the summer semester of the academic year 2020/2021 (NCU Legal Bulletin of 2021, item 13, as amended), § 6 is replaced by the following:

"§ 6

- **1.** Diploma examinations in the summer session are conducted in a remote mode, subject to the provisions of paragraph 2.
- 2. At the request of the student, the dean, with a positive opinion of the thesis supervisor, may give permission for the examination to be conducted in a stationary mode, observing the rules of the sanitary regime.
- **3.** Examinations in the summer session are conducted in a remote mode, subject to paragraph 4.
- 4. Examinations completing courses referred to in §1 paragraph 2 and 3 may be conducted in a stationary mode while observing a sanitary regime. Permission to conduct examinations in the mode referred to in the first sentence is given by the dean in consultation with the person teaching the subject.
 - 5. Paragraphs 3 and 4 shall apply mutatis mutandis to examinations in the summer resit session, subject to the provisions of paragraph 6.
 - 6. At the student's request, the dean may give permission for an examination to be conducted in a stationary mode."

The order comes into force on 1 July 2021.
