Order No. 185

by the Rector of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 27 September 2021

on preventing the spreading of SARS-CoV-2 virus among members of the academic community of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toru between 1 October 2021 and 28 February 2022

Pursuant to § 52 section 3 of Decree No. 37 by the Senate of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of 16 April 2019 Statute of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (NCU Legal Bulletin from 2019, item 120 as amended), in relations to Decree by the Council of Ministers of 6 May 2021 on establishing particular restrictions, orders and prohibitions due to the state of pandemic (Journal of Laws of 2021 item 861 as amended.)

it is ordered, as follows:

§ 1

The following rules for preventing the spreading of SARS- CoV-2 virus among the members of the academic community of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, hereinafter referred to as “the University” are hereby introduced”.

§ 2

1. The University buildings are open to employees, doctoral students, students, and participants of other forms of education, as well as lessees of facilities located in those buildings, and other persons who are in them at the consent of relevant University authorities.
2. Detailed rules for the use of University buildings and their preparation for users are set out in the appendix to this order.

§ 3

1. Domestic and foreign business trips of academic staff, doctoral students and students of the University, as well as the arrival of domestic and foreign guests of the University, shall take place with the approval of the dean, head of the doctoral school or head of the organizational unit, respectively, and in compliance with sanitary requirements.
2. Domestic and foreign business trips of non-academic staff shall be conducted with the consent of the Chancellor or the Vice-Chancellor for Collegium Medicum - in the case of administrative and service staff, or the head of the organizational unit - in the case of engineering and technical staff and librarians - in which the staff member is employed, and in compliance with sanitary requirements

§ 4

Conferences, concerts, exhibitions, sports competitions and other events organized by the University shall be held in accordance with the requirements arising from separate regulations.

§ 5

1. Research, research-didactic, didactic, auxiliary and service units of the University and doctoral schools operate in accordance with the rules and range of their functioning, in compliance with sanitary requirements resulting from other regulations.
2. Head of units referred to in section 1, may announce detailed rules of a given unit's functioning at the approval of relevant vice-Rector.
3. Detailed rules for the functioning of an organizational unit shall be published on the University's website and in the manner customarily accepted in that unit.
4. Regulations from section 2 and section 3 shall be applied to the Dormitory Department and Dormitory Department of CM.

§ 6

1. No more than two persons may be accommodated in a single dormitory room, unless they run a joint household, with the exception of section 2.
2. In especially justified cases, a relevant vice-Rector for student affairs may give approval for accommodating additional persons in dormitory rooms.
3. Accommodation in dormitories is possible only after prior arrangement of its date with dormitory administration.
4. A limitation is imposed on visits– one person per one dormitory inhabitant, with no possibility of guest spending the night in the inhabitant's room.

§ 7

1. Resignation from living in a dormitory takes place on the day of filing a written motion.
2. In the event of leaving the dormitory, the accommodation fee shall be reduced in proportion to the period of residence in the dormitory, so that:
 - 1) residents who have left the dormitory by the 15th of a given month shall pay a fee for the stay in that month equal to half the monthly rate;
 - 2) residents who left the dormitory after the 15th of a given month shall pay the full amount for the stay in that month.

§ 8

1. Employees, doctoral students, students and participants of other forms of education can send any information or questions related to the University's functioning in the conditions of epidemiological hazard to the address koronawirus@umk.pl.
2. All information related to the University's functioning in terms of the issues included in this order shall be provided only by NCU Press Team.

§ 9

Organization of education at the University is regulated by a separate order by the Rector.

§ 10

The Chancellor, by regulation, shall define detailed rules for the functioning of the University's administration and the performance of work-related duties by engineering staff, maintenance staff and librarians during the period from October 1, 2021, through February 28, 2022, in connection with the prevention, countermeasure, and suppression of COVID-19.

§ 11

All matters not included in this order shall be resolved by the Rector.

§ 12

Order no. 161 by the NCU Rector of 30 June 2021 on limiting the spreading of SARS-CoV-2 virus among members of the academic community of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń between 1 July and 30 September 2021 (NCU Legal Bulletin of 2021, item. 267) is hereby repealed

§ 13

The order becomes effective as of 1 October 2021.
