## Rules for the use of student houses

- 1. Placing hand sanitizer near the entrance and placing information in Polish and English on the obligatory use of the hand sanitizer by all persons entering the building.
- 2. Following social distancing rules, and especially avoiding gatherings.
- 3. Covering the mouth and nose with a mask in common areas (corridors, halls, staircases, elevators, toilets, kitchens).
- 4. Introducing restrictions on the maximum number of persons allowed at the same time in public areas, such as a kitchen, toilet, laundry, and recreation rooms.
- 5. Providing a spare room for isolation equipped with personal protective equipment, sanitizer, and a non-contact thermometer.
- 6. Informing the residents of student houses about the obligation to report immediately to a student house manager by phone and avoiding common areas in the building in case of symptoms indicating COVID-19.
- 7. Displaying information on the obligation to follow the rules regarding: hand hygiene; hygiene practices during coughing and sneezing; avoiding touching the mouth, nose, and eyes; avoiding close contact with infected people, especially those with respiratory symptoms.
- 8. Displaying instructions on washing hands in sanitary rooms, and near hand sanitizer dispensers instructions on hand disinfection.
- 9. Displaying necessary phone numbers for the Sanitary and Epidemiological Station and medical service.
- 10.Providing disinfection equipment and disinfectants, monitoring daily cleaning works, with particular regard to frequent disinfection of high-touch surfaces handrails, door handles, light switches, handles, flat surfaces, including worktops in kitchens.
- 11.Providing the employees of student houses with access to personal protective equipment (protective masks, disposable gloves) and hand sanitizers.
