NOMINATIONS DEADLINES (PARTNERS)

- **1st June** - Winter semester and whole academic year
- **1st November** - Summer semester

APPLICATIONS DEADLINES (STUDENTS)

- **15th June** - Winter semester and whole academic year
- **15th November** - Summer semester

NOMINATION & APPLICATION STEP BY STEP

- **Step I: Nomination**

Partner university nominates their students and sends their nomination via NCU form

- **Step II: Application**

Nominated students have to register via



[Online Application System](#) and complete the application

- **Step III: Faculty coordinator accepts your LA**

Faculty coordinator verifies student's Learning Agreement and approves it or requests to make some changes

- **Step IV: Sending the Invitation Letter**

Once the application is completed and Learning Agreement accepted by the Faculty Coordinator, an official Invitation Letter will be sent directly to the student

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- At least an intermediate level (**B2**) of **English** or **Polish**
- We accept **official proficiency language certificates** (like TOEFL, Cambridge, IELTS) or “internal” University language proficiency forms (certified by a Language Teacher at the Sending Institution)
- Our Coordinators may additionally wish to check your language competence individually e.g. by an online test or a MS Teams interview
