 - a. the right to access personal data and subject to the law: right to rectify these data,
 - b. the right to request the removal of or restriction of processing of your data,
 - c. the right to object the processing of your data,
 - d. the right to transfer your personal data processed in IT systems to another controller.
- 5. The provision of personal data by you is voluntary, but necessary for the purpose for which it was collected.
- 6. Where processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent at any time, but such withdrawal shall have no legal effect in relation to the processing which was based on the consent issued prior to its withdrawal.
- 7. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
- 8. Your personal data may be made available to other entities such as: a law office cooperating with us.
- 9. (3) We do not plan to transfer your personal data outside the EEA (including the European Union, Norway, Liechtenstein and Iceland) as of the date of the collection of your data without prejudice to the possibility of such transfer in future, which fact will be communicated to you in good time.
- 10. No automated decision making activities will be carried out in relation to you nor will your data be subject to automated profiling.
