RESOLUTION No. 66

of the Senate of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 25 November 2025

**amending Resolution No. 37 of the Senate of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of
16 April 2019 Statute of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń**

Pursuant to Article 28(1)(1) and Article 34(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended)

i t i s o r d e r e d as follows:

§ 1

Resolution No. 37 of the Senate of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of 16 April 2019 introduces the following amendments to the Statutes of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (Legal Bulletin of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of 2024, item 10):

1) after Article 33, Article 33a shall be added, reading as follows:

„§ 33a

- 1. The Institute of Advanced Studies is a university research unit operating to provide a permanent platform for scientific research conducted at the highest international level and to maintain good practices and achievements as a research university, a status which the University acquired under the 'Initiative of Excellence – Research University' programme.**
- 2. The Institute of Advanced Studies is established by the Rector by way of an order.**
- 3. The Institute of Advanced Studies comprises the Centre for Modern Interdisciplinary Technologies and, in particular, the university areas of research excellence established under the 'Initiative of Excellence – Research University' programme.**
- 4. No more than four named professor positions may be created at the Institute of Advanced Studies for researchers of international renown and impeccable reputation.**
- 5. The positions referred to in Article 4 shall be created by the University Senate at the request of the Rector's Council, which shall designate their patron from among**

outstanding researchers who have rendered distinguished service to the history and development of the University.

6. **Employment for the position of professor referred to in Article 4 shall be by way of a competition conducted by a committee composed of the Rector's college and the relevant dean and chair of the scientific discipline council. Other academic teachers shall be seconded to the Institute of Advanced Studies by the Rector for a fixed period or entrusted with duties within the Institute of Advanced Studies at the faculty.**
7. **Articles 34(3)-(6) shall apply accordingly to the Institute of Advanced Studies. ”;**

2) Article 34(1) shall read as follows:

„ 1. A university research unit, subject to Article 33a, may be a research centre whose task is to conduct scientific research of national or international importance, of particular significance to the University and the development of science and knowledge, as well as cooperation with the socio-economic environment.’;

3) after Article 166, Article 166a shall be added, reading as follows:

„166a

The first director of the Institute of Advanced Studies, referred to in Article 33a, is appointed by the Rector no later than one month after the establishment of the Institute.”.

§ 2

The resolution shall enter into force on 25 November 2025.
