ORDER No. 53

Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń

of 27 October 2022

on the organisation of the academic year 2022/2023

Pursuant to art. 23.1 of the Act of 30 August 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 574 as amended) and § 12 of the resolution No. 39 of the Senate of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of 30 April 2019 - Study Regulations of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń (NCU Legal Bulletin 2019, item 277, as amended).

it is ruled as follows:

Article 1

1. The following framework organisation of the academic year 2022/2023 in the Toruń and Bydgoszcz parts of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń is established:

WINTER SEMESTER	from 1 October 2022 to 19 February 2023
Inauguration of the academic year 2022/2023	3 October 2022
Teaching classes	from 4 October 2022 to 22 December 2022
Winter holidays	from 23 December 2022 to 8 January 2023
Teaching classes	from 9 January 2023 to 6 February 2023
Winter examination session	from 7 February 2023 to 18 February 2023
UNIVERSITY DAY	19 February 2023
SUMMER SEMESTER	from 20 February 2023 to 30 September 2023
Inter-semester break in teaching classes	from 20 February 2023 to 5 March 2023
Winter examination session – resit examination session	from 6 March 2023 to 19 March 2023

Teaching classes	from 6 March 2023 to 5 April 2023
Spring holidays	from 6 April 2023 to 11 April 2023
Teaching classes	from 12 April 2023 to 29 June 2023
Summer examination session	from 30 June 2023 to 13 July 2023
Summer holidays	from 14 July 2023 to 30 September 2023
Resit examination session	from 1 September 2023 to 14 September 2023

2. The deadline for obtaining course credits and passing all examinations included in the study plan for the winter semester is 19 March and for the summer semester is 20 September 2023.
3. The following is established in order to enable the delivery of classes in accordance with the study plan:
 - 1) on 10 November (Thursday) 2022, classes scheduled for Friday will be held;
 - 2) on 14 June (Wednesday) 2023, classes scheduled for Friday will be held.
4. Classes scheduled for 19-22 December and 6 February may be held on other dates in the winter semester. The decision in this matter is made by the dean of the faculty. The provision of art. 3.4 shall apply accordingly.

Article 2

1. The following are public holidays within the meaning of the Act of 18 January 1951 on Public Holidays (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1920):
 - 1) 1 November 2022 (All Saints' Day);
 - 2) 11 November 2022 (Poland Independence Day);
 - 3) 6 January 2023 (Epiphany);
 - 4) 1 May 2023 (National Holiday);
 - 5) 3 May 2023 (3 May Constitution Day);
 - 6) 28 May 2023 (Pentecost);
 - 7) 8 June 2023 (Corpus Christi).
2. The following are additional days off from teaching classes:
 - 1) 3 October 2022 (inauguration of the academic year);
 - 2) 31 October 2022;
 - 3) 2 November 2022;
 - 4) 2 May 2023;
 - 5) 12-14 May 2023 (yearly student carnival in Collegium Medicum);
 - 6) 19-21 May 2023 (yearly student carnival in Toruń).

Article 3

1. Schedules of teaching in full-time studies are established by the units providing the programmes and are approved by the deans of faculties and published in the USOS system or on the faculty website no later than 10 days before the start of the semester.

2. Changes to schedules and dates of sessions in part-time studies may only be made with the approval of the dean.
3. The dean shall inform, without undue delay, students, doctoral students and teaching staff of the changes made and shall update the schedules of classes in the USOS system or on the websites, as appropriate.

Article 4

The dean of the faculty, after consultation with the faculty council of student government, may set other dates for the examination session for students in their final semester of studies provided that the implementation of the full degree programme is ensured.

Article 5

1. Order No. 93 of the Rector of the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń of 6 May 2022 on the organisation of the academic year 2022/2023 (NCU Legal Bulletin 2022, item 155 as amended) is repealed.
2. The Order becomes effective as of 27 October 2022.
